College Scholarship Application

East Logan Water District proudly announces its annual scholarships. There will be two (2) scholarships awarded to two senior students. Each will receive a \$1,000 scholarship.

Who qualifies?

- (1) Only students whose parents or guardians have water service in good standing with East Logan Water District qualify for these scholarships. In other words, to qualify, you must reside within the service of East Logan Water District.
- (2) Applicants must have a minimum overall GPA of 2.5.
- (3) You should already be accepted to the school of your choice.
- (4) Children of East Logan Water District employees and directors are not eligible for consideration.

How will the scholarships be awarded?

Each application will be reviewed by the East Logan Water District Board of Directors.

Scholarships are awarded for one (1) academic year, in two (2) equal parts, for the fall and spring semesters. These scholarships will be awarded one time only and may not be reapplied for. A minimum overall GPA of 2.5 must be obtained for both semesters of the scholarship. Recipients will be notified of the award prior to graduation and will be recognized at the graduation ceremonies.

What are the components of the application?

Applications for the East Logan Water District scholarship must include the following:

1. Essay: Tap Water Versus Bottled Water (see below)
2. High School Transcript
3. Small photo (stapled to application for publication purposes)
4. Two (2) letters of recommendation (one from teacher, one from community leader)
5. Copy of SAT/ACT scores



Application deadline

Scholarship applications must be turned into the offices of East Logan Water District by 4:00 p.m. on April 6, 2012.
